Required Documents and Necessary information for Travel and Entry into Liberia, West Africa



1. PASSPORT

There must be 6 months remaining before expiration.

2. VISAS

We will apply for the Liberian Visa as a group. Please complete the VISAS applications and send proper fees via money order. Make all money orders payable to: **Embassy of the Republic of Liberia**

3. IMMUNIZATIONS

a. **Yellow fever shots**

b. **Tetanus shots**

c. **Malaria and bacteria medication**
[Doxycycline 100mg cap]

d. **Hepatitis A & B Series**
[Consult your doctor or go to your Medical Center for the required shots for a trip to Liberia, West Africa]

e. **Keep your shots' record with your Passport!**

4. Personal Needs

- a. Your own towel and wash cloth
- b. Rubber slippers
- c. Bar of Soap

For the Men

1. At least 14 changes of underwear. Because of the heat, you will shower and change twice a day.
2. At Least 14 shirts.
3. Not too many suits [light material, not heavy fabric]
4. Bring a White Outfit to wear on Missionary Day, Wednesday. Men wear All White!!
5. Generally, men wear shirts and ties.

For the Women

1. Summer clothes. Light summer dresses or skirts and blouses.
2. Wednesday is Missionary Day, and the dress code is ALL White.
3. Women wear a head covering in the services.
Recommend: Get the African wrap head covering.
4. NO short dresses or skirts.
5. NO form fitting dresses or skirts.
- 6 NO low neck lines or blouses or skirts.
7. Prepare to shower and change two times a day because of the heat.
